New partnership brings innovative loan program to women entrepreneurs in Nova Scotia

August 17, 2023 - Centre for Women in Business becomes 7th Canadian loan fund partner for WEOC National Loan Program

Today the Women's Enterprise Organizations of Canada (WEOC) welcomes Centre for Women in Business as the newest Loan Fund Partner for the WEOC National Loan Program, increasing access to funding and support for women entrepreneurs across Nova Scotia.

CWB joins six other regional Loan Fund Partners: WeBC, Alberta Women Entrepreneurs (AWE). Women Entrepreneurs of Saskatchewan (WESK), Women's Enterprise Centre of Manitoba (WECM), PARO Centre for Women's Enterprise, and Newfoundland & Labrador Organization of Women Entrepreneurs (NLOWE).

"I am thrilled that women entrepreneurs in Nova Scotia will now have access to a loan program that offers not only much-needed capital, but the additional wrap-around supports and services that help lead to long-term growth and success," says Alison Kirkland, CEO, WEOC.

WEOC was named a delivery partner for the Government of Canada's new Women Entrepreneurship Loan Fund in August 2022. Over the past year, WEOC has been changing the lending landscape by offering accessible and inclusive loan services to Canadian women entrepreneurs.

The WEOC National Loan Program is available to all business structures - from sole proprietors to incorporated businesses to social enterprises. Entrepreneurs can apply through a WEOC loan partner organization in their region.

Key information:

- The loan program offers entrepreneurs loans in any amount up to \$50,000, flexible terms, as well as tailored business advising, training, and loan aftercare supports.
- The first WEOC loan went out in November 2022 and since then more than \$2.5 million has been disbursed to women entrepreneurs in diverse industries across Canada.
- The loan program is currently distributed as a partnership with seven loan fund partners located in B.C., Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Nova Scotia, and Newfoundland and Labrador.
